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INSTRUCTIONS

SCRABBLE Pocket Puzzle — is a new pocket word game designed to test your knowledge of words and your ability to rearrange the scrambled letters on your puzzle board to form these words. SCRABBLE Pocket Puzzle — is a word-quizz game plus a fascinating, brain-teasing puzzle. SCRABBLE Pocket Puzzle — will make you more adept at creating new SCRABBLE words.

SCRABBLE Pocket Puzzle — LETTER DISTRIBUTION and VALUES:

RULES

- Begin at the top row, and moving downward to the second row, etc., IN ROTATION, arrange as many horizontal 4-letter words as you can. Complete all 7 horizontal words —and get a bonus of 50 points.
- While completing the seven 4-letter words horizontally, try, at the same time, to complete vertical words. Only when all seven horizontal words are completed, may you add to your score the point value of the vertical words you have formed.
- Try to arrange your words so that the most valued letters are on the 2nd, 4th, and 6th rows—the BONUS ROWS. The points scored for the words on a bonus row are MULTIPLIED by the BONUS NUMBER that appears on the frame to the left of that row.
- Bonus numbers appear on the bottom frame also. Multiply your vertical word score by the proper bonus number.
- The blank space can be used as a joker—that is, any letter you wish. No points will be given for the blank except if it is used to form the 7th horizontal word. In that case, refer to point value chart for proper scoring.

For example, if the word "ZERO" were formed on any horizontal row from the 1st to the 6th, the points scored for the word would be → Total = 3 points

However, if the word "ZERO" were arranged on the 7th row, after 6 other horizontal words have been formed, the points scored would be → Total = 13 points

IMPORTANT NOTE:
 There is no Q, V, X or Z. Use Joker instead.

SCRABBLE Pocket Puzzle — will familiarize the player with the point-scoring system of SCRABBLE® since the letter values are identical.
