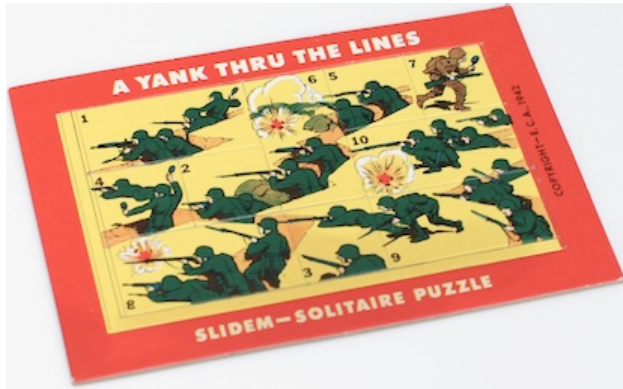


# Slidem WWII - "A Yank Through The Lines"



## INSTRUCTIONS

**FIRST**—Gently press out and separate all pieces inside frame. Throw away the narrow piece which is on left side and bottom of puzzle and inside of frame.

**NEXT**—Place frame on table or other smooth surface. Replace all numbered pieces of picture inside frame in position as shown in "START" below.

**THEN**—Remove #1 piece and lay it aside. You are now ready to start. You must SLIDE the pieces around inside the frame, WITHOUT PICKING UP any pieces at any time. The object is to get all the numbered pieces in position as shown in "FINISH" below, or to bring #7 piece from lower left corner to upper right corner.

The last move is to replace #1 piece and complete the picture. You have succeeded in getting "A YANK THRU THE LINES". This can be done in 17 moves. How many moves can you do it in?
